Regulations for complementary accommodation campaign - September 2024

- 1. The campaign takes place through the https://esks.pw.edu.pl system.
- 2. Only correctly and timely completed electronic applications will be considered for the campaign.
- 3. The application deadlines are specified in the Schedule of complementary accommodation campaign September 2024.
- 4. The campaign is intended for all wishing to live in WUT Dormitories.
- 5. The allocation of places is determined by the order of application and the following rules:
 - 1. The first to be considered will be the applications of newly admitted students and doctoral students to Warsaw University of Technology (a newly admitted person is a person who begins studies at Warsaw University of Technology in October 2024).
 - a) In order to receive the priority mentioned above, it is necessary to submit an application via your USOS account and mark "I am a newly admitted student or doctoral student of WUT"
 - b) Applications of persons who untruthfully check the box "I am a newly admitted student or PhD student of WUT" will be considered in the third order of priority.
 - 2. Second priority will be given to applications of those who have the status of a student or doctoral student of PW, in order to take advantage of such priority, it will be necessary to submit an application through the USOS account.
 - 3. In the third order, all other applications will be considered.
- 6. By submitting an application, person applies only for a place in one of the WUT dormitories. Places in specific rooms will be allocated at random, by decision of the Quartermaster. Possible changes to the allocation will be possible after accommodation has been provided as part of the accommodation campaign "Bank of Places".
- 7. Submitted applications must be formally correct, i.e. contain all mandatory fields filled in and have correct data entered, in particular the address of permanent residence. In the case of giving as the address of permanent residence, the address of the WUT Dormitories, applications will be returned for correction for formal reasons. Failure to correct the application in this regard will result in its rejection for formal reasons.
- 8. Only persons who have not been punished with disciplinary penalties during their accommodation in the WUT Dormitories of Warsaw University of Technology may participate in the campaign.

- 9. Only people who at the time of processing the application will be billed to the WUT Dormitories, that is, will not have any arrears in payment, can participate in the campaign. Persons who do not live in the WUT Dorms at the time of application, but lived previously, must have a "settled" status. Otherwise, their applications will be rejected on formal grounds.
- 10. Those who receive a place in one of the WUT Dormitories will be required to pay a reservation fee in the amount of PLN 300 to the account number indicated in the referral or by payment card at the time of check-in.
- 11. Reservation fee must be paid (credited to WUT accounts) no later than at the time of checkin.
- 12. In the case of a reservation fee in an amount greater than the established 300 PLN, the overpayment will be credited to the first month's accommodation payment.
- 13. A certificate of allocation of a place will be issued only after the reservation fee has been credited.
- 14. Referrals issued under the campaign will be valid from September 27 to October 7, 2024.
- 15. Loss of status as a student of WUT or a PhD WUT student after the allocation of a place does not result in the loss of the place reservation.
